lites of Annachal Gradesh SLBC, have quarter for your MINUTES OF THE STATE LEVEL BANKERS' COMMITTEE MEETING FOR THE STATE OF ARUNACHAL PRADESH FOR THE QUARTER ENDED MARCH 2023 HELD ON 27.07.2023.

> The State Level Bankers' Committee Meeting for the State of Arunachal Pradesh for the Quarter ended March 2023 was held on 27.07.2023 under the Chairmanship of Shri Dharmendra IAS, Chief Secretary, Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh and Co-Chairmanship of Shri Amaresh Kumar Jha, General Manager and Convenor (SLBC), State Bank of India, Local Head Office, Guwahati at the Dorjee Khandu State Convention Centre, Itanagar, Arunachal Pradesh.

The following dignitaries also participated in the meeting: -

- (1) Dr. Sharat Chauhan, IAS Principal Secretary, Finance, Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh
- (2) Shri Amarnath Talwade, IAS, Secretary RD&PR, Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh
- (3) Shri R K Sharma, Secretary Planning, Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh
- (4) Shri Abhijit Mazumdar, General Manager, Reserve Bank of India

The meeting started with a welcome speech and Key note Address by Shri Amaresh Kumar Jha General Manager, Network-1, State Bank of India, Local Head Office, Guwahati. While welcoming the Chief Secretary, all the Secretaries and dignitaries of the State Govt. and dignitaries from RBI, NABARD and all officials of Banks operating in the State, Shri Jha briefly highlighted the achievements of the Banks in the State in terms of growth in deposits and Advances, improvement in CD ratio, 148% achievement of Annual Credit Plan for the year 2022-23 under the priority sector. He also assured the Chief Secretary that Banks would strive to achieve the ACP target of Rs.791.92 crores the year 2023-24

He urged Bandhan Bank, IndusInd Bank, Yes Bank, NESFB and APSCAB to sanction loans under the PMMY.

(Action point: Concerned Banks)

For ensuring universal Banking to all adults in unbanked areas, the General Manager remarked that there should be co-ordinated approach from the State Govt., Telecom Service providers and Banks.

(Action point: All concerned Departments & Banks).

Shri Dharmendra, IAS, Chief Secretary, Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh in his opening remarks observed that

- 1. Banks should open Branches in rural and remote areas in all the Districts to ensure uniform presence across the State instead of concentrating at few places (Action point: All Banks) like Naharlagun, Itanagar or Pasighat.
- 2. Significant improvements shown in CD ratio, growth in Deposit and Advances, 148% achievement of the Annual Credit Plan show that the State is conducive to growth and it is in a positive trajectory.
- 3. Sanction of loans under the Atma Nirbhar Schemes for the year 2022-23 is very slow. Banks should dispose off all the remaining applications by 15.08.2023.
- 4. All Private sector Banks should participate and sanction loans under the Atma Nirbhar Schemes of the Government of Arunachal Pradesh. (Action point: All Private Sector Banks)

(Action point: All Concerned Banks)



Banks should work on broad based economic indicators like digital transformation, Financial Inclusion, women empowerment and Social Securities.

(Action point: All Banks).

6. The Government is aware that Banks are looking towards availability of adequate infrastructure, connectivity communication etc..

(Action point:

This was followed by presentation of Agenda items by Shri S. Ranjit Singh, Coordinator SLBC for the State of Arunachal Pradesh

The minutes of the previous SLBC meeting dated 12.04.2023 were confirmed by the House. Further, the Action Taken Report was put up for discussion and observations were made as under:

AGENDA 1: ATR

- a) Banks which are under performing and pulling down the overall performance are identified. CBI, P&SB, AXIS Bank, Bandhan Bank, Yes Bank are having CD ratio less than 20% whereas BOM, Indian Bank, AXIS Bank, HDFC and ICICI have not sanction loan under Atma Nirbhar Schemes. (Action point: Concerned Banks).
- b) Bank branches in Tirap, Changlang and Longding districts are now opening accounts of SHGs and all the remaining applications will be opened by 31.07.2023 (Action point: Concerned Banks).
- c) The status on opening of Bank branches was reviewed and found to be as under:

d) Bank of Baroda submitted that RSETI at Pasighat will be opened by 14.08.2023. (Action point: Bank of Baroda)

e)AXIS Bank assured that all the applications under the DDUSY in East Kameng District and Papumpare will be sanctioned on priority. (Action point: AXIS Bank)

f) Out of 2136 Gram Panchayats 1923 have been covered under the Jan Suraksha campaign starting from 01.04.2023 and the remaining GPs would be covered by (Action point: All concerned Banks) 31.07.2023.



g) Scale of Finance and Cropping season for the State of Arunachal Pradesh for the year 2023-24 have been approved.

h) Out of 294 applications forwarded to the Banks under the DDUSY for the year 2022-23 187 applications have been sanctioned and 92 applications are still pending at the Bank branches. Banks should dispose off the pending applications by 15.08.2023. (Action point: Concerned Banks)

i) Punjab National Bank may take up with the concerned Dy. Commissioner for allotment of land for setting up RSETI at Namsai. (Action point: PNB)

j) Concerned Banks should open 38 Branches as assured during the Special SLBC Meeting on 02.05.2023 by 30.09.2023.

(Action point: Concerned Banks).

Agenda 2. CD ratio:

- a) CD ratio of the State has improved from 31.37% as on 31.03.2022 to 34.75% as on 31.03.2023.
- b) However, it is well below the RBI benchmark of 60%.

Agenda 3

- a) Banks have achieved 148.32% of the ACP 2022-23 for the year 2022-23 by sanctioning an amount of Rs.888.20 crores as against the target of Rs.598.82
- b) The achievement was mainly due to Atma Nirbhar Schemes of the Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh and DDUSY.
- c) The priority sector lending in the State stands at Rs.3682.40 crores i.e. at 39.14%. The SLBC requested the Reserve Bank of India, to increase the priority sector limit in respect of Housing loans as many such loans sanctioned in the State are classified in the non-priority sector.

(Action point: SLBC & RBI)

Agenda 4

- a) Banks have sanctioned 6815 number of Mudra loans amounting to Rs.133.21 crores during 2022-23 as against sanction of 4004 loans amounting to Rs.67.57 crores during the previous year 2021-22.
- b) Banks have sanctioned 719 loans amounting to Rs.78.56 crores under the Deen dayal Upadhyay Swavalamban Yajana (DDUSY) since inception. An amount of Rs.104.00 crores has been released as Subsidy. All the pending 92 applications should be disposed off by 15.08.2023. (Action point: All concerned Banks).

- c) Shri Aftab Ahmad Mallick proposed convergence of the PMEGP and DDUSY Scheme.
- d) Banks have sanctioned 250 number of loans under PMEGP during 2022-23 as against the target of 235.
- e) RBI observed that loan applications will be returned or rejected with valid (Action point: All Banks) reasons.



Agenda 5.

a) As per directive of Union Minister of State for Finance during the Special SLBC Meeting held on 02.05.2023 in Itanagar SLBC has identified 400 number of unbanked villages in the State with population upto 100 or households upto 25. SLBC has approved the list for deletion of the same from the list of 768 villages provided by DFS for coverage by Banking Units.

This may be shared with DFS.

(Action point: SLBC)

b) The remaining villages are to be covered by the allotted Banks.

(Action point: Concerned Banks)

Report on Bakijai cases was discussed. An amount of Rs.0.31 crores in 23 accounts was recovered during the quarter under review. The Chief Secretary advised Banks to contact Dy. Commissioners regularly and follow up meticulously.

RSETI, Yupia has achieved the training target of 360 by providing training to 384 trainees during 2022-23. However, the settlement rate is only 42.18%

h) In Anjaw District, Connectivity provided by service provider Airtel has been shifted from Hayulliang to Kibithoo. Therefore SBI branches in Anjaw are facing difficulty in daily transaction.

Shri Hemant Kumar Gadge, DGM, SLBC Guwahati observed that

a) Special DLRC Meeting is to be conducted in all the districts with Hon'ble MPs as invitees before 15.08.2023.

b) Campaign in unclaimed deposit Scheme of 100 days 100 page should be successfully carried out.

(Action point: All Banks)

c) Credit camps should be held in the districts of Changlang, Lower Dibang Valley, Namsai, Papumpare and Tawang

(Action point: LDMs & Banks)

d) Three aspirational blocks have been identified in the State- Chowkham, Pangchau and Tali.

(Action point: Concerned LDMs).

Shri Abhijit Mazumdar, General Manager, Reserve Bank of India observed that

- i) RBI Office in Itanagar may be functional by the last week of August 2023.
- ii) Excellent Schemes have been brought out by the State Govt. Banks should be proactive and sincere to implement the same.
- ii) It is observed that APRB investment is 70% and lending is only 30%. This trend should be reversed.
