

MINUTES OF THE 67th SLBC MEETING FOR THE QUARTER ENDED JUNE 2021- CUM - SPECIAL SLBC MEETING TO REVIEW FINANCIAL INCLUSION AND FINANCIAL LITERACY INITIATIVES HELD ON 28TH SEPTEMBER 2021 AT 10.45 A.M IN THE CONFERENCE HALL OF THE MANIPUR SECRETARIAT SOUTH BLOCK.

The meeting of the 67th SLBC was held under the chairmanship of Dr. Rajesh Kumar, IAS, Chief Secretary, Government of Manipur. Shri S. K. Sahoo, DGM (SLBC) SBI LHO gave a brief welcome address and welcomed all the participants in the meeting. Thereafter, Shri. R.S. Ramesh, CGM, SBI, North Eastern Circle presented the keynote address to the House.

The SLBC Coordinator, Shri. Hubert S.Z. Khobung, then proceeded with the meeting agenda wise discussion/deliberations of the House.

Agenda no. 1: Adoption of the minutes of the 66th SLBC meeting held on 28th June 2021:

GM RBI remarked that ***"Inclusion of Financial Education in School Curriculum"*** was not included in the agenda item of the last SLBC meeting, and that it needed to be included till the process is completed by Education Department. DGM, SLBC replied that it has been included in this meeting and will continue to be included in all SLBC meetings henceforth. The meeting minutes of the 66th SLBC meeting was adopted by the House.

Agenda no. 2: Review of Action taken Report of the 66th SLBC Meeting

Opening of RSETIs:

Kakching District: The State Mission Director (SMD), Manipur SRLM informed the House that the identified temporary rooms at ITI building which were used as COVID Care Centre have been vacated and is now available for starting the RSETI by PNB. PNB informed that the campus is almost ready and it has initiated steps for operationalizing the RSETI, which is expected to be completed within October. The Chairman advised PNB to take all necessary steps including identification of trainers and beneficiaries, so that the RSETI is ready for inauguration by **1st November, 2021**.

Bishnupur District: The State Mission Director (SMD), Manipur SRLM informed the House that Deputy Commissioner, Bishnupur had convened a meeting on 7th August, 2021, wherein the rooms and buildings were identified for setting up the RSETI. PNB informed that repairing & renovation works are in progress. The Chairman advised PNB to take all necessary steps including identification of trainers and beneficiaries, so that the RSETI is ready for inauguration by **1st November, 2021**.

Senapati District: The State Mission Director (SMD), Manipur SRLM informed the House that land allocation in Senapati District is completed. The Chairman advised SBI to initiate steps for construction of the RSETI in

the allotted site. In the meantime, the RSETI is to function from any temporary location, which can be identified with assistance from DC/Senapati and take all necessary steps including identification of trainers and beneficiaries, so that the RSETI is ready for inauguration by **1st November, 2021.**

Imphal East District: Pending finalization of land allotment, the Chairman advised PNB to identify any temporary location with assistance from DC/Imphal East and take all necessary steps including identification of trainers and beneficiaries, so that the RSETI is ready for inauguration by **1st November, 2021.**

Chandel District: The State Mission Director (SMD), Manipur SRLM informed the House that land allocation is under process and has been forwarded to Revenue Department by the District Administration. In the meantime, a temporary building has been identified at DC Office Complex. The Chairman advised SBI to take all necessary steps including identification of trainers and beneficiaries, so that the RSETI is ready at the temporary building for inauguration by **1st November, 2021**

Ukhrul District: The State Mission Director (SMD), Manipur SRLM informed the House that land at about 3 km east of Ukhrul Mini Secretariat has been identified. However, which bank will operate the RSETI is yet to be finalized. The matter was placed before the SLBC to take a decision in this regard. The House observed that since PNB was taking up the RSETI in Kakching District (where SBI is the Lead Bank) and since Ukhrul has been allotted to SBI more than 2 years back, it may be taken up by SBI. Accordingly, SBI was advised to inform its Corporate Office about the decision of the House.

Imphal West District : The State Mission Director (SMD), Manipur SRLM informed the House that no updates were received from the District Administration/ Concerned bank. The Chairman advised DC/Imphal West to assist in identification of temporary location, pending allocation of land as soon as possible. Thereafter, SBI to take up all necessary steps including identification of trainers and beneficiaries, so that the RSETI is ready at the temporary location for inauguration by **1st November, 2021.**

Tamenglong District: The State Mission Director (SMD), Manipur SRLM informed the House that no updates were received from the District Administration/ Concerned bank. The Chairman advised PNB to take assistance from DC/Tamenglong for identification of temporary location, pending allocation of land. Thereafter, PNB to take up all necessary steps including identification of trainers and beneficiaries, so that the RSETI is ready at the temporary location for inauguration by **1st November, 2021.**

(Action: Concerned DC/ SBI/PNB)

Agenda no 3: Review of Deposits, Advances and CD Ratio:

The SLBC coordinator informed the House that the CD ratio at the end of the Quarter ended June 2021 for the State stood at 66 % which is above the National bench mark of 60%. The bank-wise CD ratio was reviewed.

All banks with CD ratio below 40 % were advised by the Chairman to improve their performance by the next quarter. Further, banks with CD ratio below 60 % were advised to achieve the National benchmark of 60%.

(Action: All Banks)

Agenda 4: Review of Credit Disbursement:

The House reviewed the overall ACP achievement including the Sector-wise achievement during the quarter. The overall ACP achievement for the Quarter stood at 22%.

The House observed that the overall achievement under ACP was below the desired levels. The Chairman observed that the banks were not performing well, particularly in the Agriculture sector as well as Other Priority Sector. He viewed with concern the persistent poor performance in Agriculture Sector and urged the banks to step up their performance. The House expressed displeasure at the performance of BOM, PSB, INDUSIND and YES Bank who have not made a single lending to the Sector during the last Quarter. All banks in general and these banks in particular were advised to step up their performance and achieve proportionate ACP target on a month to month basis.

CGM SBI, NE Circle, informed the House that RBI has identified 14 districts of Manipur (i.e., all Districts with the exception of Jiribam and Imphal West) as credit-deficit districts and advised the banks to show improvement in these districts in the next quarter. He further informed that RBI was incentivising banks by assigning higher weightage (125%) to the incremental priority sector credit in these districts.

On the issue of low credit off-take, particularly in priority sector, GM-OIC spoke about the RBI policy measures such as broadening the scope of Priority Sector Lending by including start-ups, enhancing the limits for lending to renewable energy sector, increasing targets for small and marginal farmers and weaker sections, incentivizing banks to augment credit flows to districts with relatively lower credit penetration. Further, with the introduction of the Payments Infrastructure Development Fund (PIDF) Scheme, RBI has taken steps to further widen the use of digital payments and digitalization. The objective of the PIDF scheme is to subsidise the deployment of payment acceptance infrastructure in Tier 3-6 centres with special focus on the NE states.

The House advised all the banks to take into consideration the above policies of RBI and strive to achieve the benchmark of 40% lending towards Priority Sector, with a target of 18% to Agriculture lending.

(Action: All Banks)

Agenda 5: Special focus on Review of financial inclusion initiatives, Expansion of Banking Network, Financial literacy, Social Security Schemes and Digitisation.

SLBC Coordinator apprised the House that as a part of the special SLBC focus on financial inclusion and financial literacy initiatives, the above agenda items have been included along with other agenda items for a focused review of the progress made in areas of financial inclusion and financial literacy parameters.

(a) Roadmap for providing banking services-villages with population below 2000:

The Convenor Bank apprised the House that since the last Sub-Committee meeting held on 08.09.2021, there are still 114 villages to be covered under any provision (banking outlet/CSP) as under:

The allotted banks namely HDFC, ICICI and PNB were advised to expedite the process and ensure coverage of all the villages by November 2021. HDFC Bank and SBI were advised to explore setting up 100 additional CSPs/BCs within November 2021.

(Action: HDFC, ICICI, PNB and SBI)

(b) DFS inadequately Uncovered villages:

HDFC Bank and ICICI Bank were advised to cover Mongken and Maomual villages which were identified as uncovered by DFS. The banks were also advised to update in the Jan Dhan Darshak App of DFS and report the updated status within a week.

(Action: HDFC and ICICI)

(c) Status of Financial Literacy Camps (FLCs):

The House observed that due to the prevailing COVID-19 restrictions, the number of FLCs were few in number. However, as the conditions have improved, banks, especially rural branches, should conduct more FLCs as

mandated by RBI and asked all the banks to achieve the target by March, 2022 and also to set quarterly targets for themselves.

The Chairman requested RBI to prepare a calendar with quarterly targets for holding of FLC camps by the banks, so that the achievement can be clearly assessed in the next SLBC meeting.

(Action: RBI/All Banks)

(d) Details of enrolment under Social Security Schemes

The performance of banks under PMJJBY, PMSBY, APY was reviewed. The House advised the banks to improve the coverage under these schemes. The performance of MRB, Bandhan bank and NESFB was viewed with concern by the Chairman and advised these banks to give special focus to these schemes which were being regularly reviewed by the Central Government.

(Action: All Banks)

Agenda 6: Aspirational District (AD) Programme:

Chandel District has been identified as the Aspirational District in the State. The performance under the various banking parameters were presented in the House. The Deputy Commissioner, Chandel highlighted the technical issues due to bifurcation of Chandel District. The Chairman advised all the banks operating in the district to improve their performance under all the required parameters of the Aspirational District programme.

(Action: DC Chandel/All Banks)

Agenda 7: Opening of Bank Branches in Unbanked Blocks & Unbanked Urban Local Bodies

The Convenor Bank informed the House that this agenda item was extensively discussed in the Sub-Committee on Unbanked Blocks, Unbanked Urban Local Bodies etc., held under the chairmanship of the Chief Secretary on 8th September, 2021. The Chairman advised all the banks to take necessary action to open the bank branches as discussed in the last Sub-Committee meeting.

DC/Chandel submitted that in the list of newly identified Unbanked Blocks, Khangbarol Block is indicated as being located in Tengenoupal District but it is actually in Chandel District. He requested the House to make the necessary rectification, which was agreed to.

During the deliberations, SBI and HDFC Bank informed the House that 3 (three) branches each will be opened shortly in different locations of the State. Bank of Baroda and Punjab & Sind Bank also informed the House that they are on the verge of opening bank branch in Somdal TD and Kasom Khullen TD respectively. Banks, including SBI, raised the issue of dual connectivity which is a pre-requisite for opening of bank branches. The

Chairman asked Director, IF to co-ordinate with Director/IT regarding providing SWAN services to the banks, and also to convene a meeting of all vendors like BSNL, AIRTEL and other Private Telecom Services providers so as to sort out the issue. Director/IT, RBI and SLBC Nodal Officer were asked to join this meeting.

The Chairman expressed satisfaction about these developments and advised the banks to expedite the process in collaboration with District Administration/ other departments so that branches are opened as stipulated in the last Sub-Committee meeting dated 8th September 2021.

Bank of India, vide their letter ZO GUW CSD TA 2021-22: 417 stated that they could not find a suitable building in Oinam Bazar and requested permission to open the branch in Nambol Bazar, about 4 kms from Oinam Bazar. The House approved opening of the branch in Nambol bazar as a temporary measure, till a suitable site is located in Oinam. The Bank was further advised to expedite the process so as to open the branch within the timeline stipulated in the Sub-Committee meeting.

(Action: DIF/All Allotted banks)

Agenda 8: 100 % Digitalisation of Kakching District

SLBC Convenor informed the House that the District is almost 100% digitalized. GM RBI congratulated and appreciated the efforts of all the banks in the District.

GM-OIC, RBI, Imphal commended the banks operating in Kakching District on achieving 99.75% digitalization of operative savings account and 98.95% digitalization of operative current accounts. She mentioned that the achievement was much above the aggregate achievement of banks at the National level, i.e. 95.9% for savings account and 89.8% for current account as on March 2021.

The House was informed that Noney District has been identified as the second Digital District in Manipur. The House approved the same, and Chairman advised the banks operating in the District to strive to achieve the target of 100% Digitization within this Financial Year.

(Action: All banks operating in the District of Noney)

Agenda 9: Inclusion of Financial Education in School Curriculum

DIF informed the house that BOSEM would be holding their next Board meeting on October 8, 2021 in which the contents to be included in school text books for inclusion of financial education in School Curriculum would be placed for approval. The Chairman advised the Education department to monitor the progress and ensure that the exercise of inclusion of Financial Education in School Curriculum in Classes 7-10 by October 15, 2021

(Action: Director Education -S)

Agenda 10: Make in Manipur Scheme (Lemon Grass)

Punjab National Bank apprised the House that 454 accounts amounting to 2.39 crores sanctioned to lemon grass farmers under Make in Manipur Scheme have become NPA. He requested government intervention to recover the amount.

The Commissioner/TC&I apprised the House that the Committee formed in this regard has submitted its Report, wherein it had been observed that there is no provision in the MoU for the Government or MFICL to act as Guarantor in case of failure to repay the loans.

The Chairman observed that this matter has been under discussion for a long time and accordingly, advised the Bank and the Department of Textiles, Commerce and Industry to jointly examine the issue and bring the matter to a logical conclusion.

(Action: PNB and TC&I Department)

Agenda 11: Loans under Government sponsored schemes

The House reviewed the performance of Government sponsored schemes under PMEGP, PMMY, DAY- NULM, DAY-NRLM, SHG and PM SVANidhi.

Commissioner Trade and Industry also informed the House that the performance under PMEGP is satisfactory. The Chairman, while commending the performance, exhorted the banks/implementing agencies to strive to achieve more in the coming quarters.

Director/ MAHUD informed the House that the performance of the State under PM SVANidhi is the best among Hilly States and North East States. He commended the efforts of participating banks and thanked them for their support. The Chairman appreciated the efforts but advised MAHUD Department and the Banks to achieve the target of 13,000 for Tranche 1 by the end of October and 2nd tranche target by the end of November.

Convenor Bank informed the House that targets under DAY-NULM, Handloom Weavers and PMEGP (approved by SLBC) are being put up in this SLBC meeting for approval of the House. Chairman advised the implementing agencies and banks to achieve the targets by 31st December, 2021.

(Action: All implementing Banks/Agencies)

Agenda 12: Recovery Act of Manipur 2003 - Bakijai cases how to implement in Manipur

DIF informed the House that as advised by the Law Department, the Rules have been reframed and referred back to Law Department. The Chairman advised DIF to tie up with Law Department and have a re-look as to whether the provisions in the Act needs amendment in view of the various developments in the last few years. The Chairman also asked RBI and all the

banks to provide feedback or suggestions, if any, to DIF at the earliest so that they may be incorporated in the Act/Rules.

(Action: DIF)

Agenda 13: CLSS component of PMAY (U)

The Department was advised by the Chairman to complete all pending process by December, 2021.

(Action: MAHUD)

Agenda 14: SRLM pending claims


The Chairman advised DIF to follow up with Finance Department and resolve the matter by October, 2021.
